MEMBERSHIP AGREEMENT

1. **AGE & WEIGHT REQUIREMENTS.** Players must meet the published age and weight requirements in order to participate in LPJF practices and games. Cheerleaders must meet the published age requirements in order to participate in LPJF practices, games, and competitions. Such requirements are a condition of membership.
2. **PHYSICALS.** Each player and cheerleader must present evidence of a sound physical condition attested to by a duly qualified Doctor of Medicine, stating O. K. to play tackle football/cheerlead with stunts, before participating in any physical training. It shall be a condition of membership to provide such proof for players/cheerleaders.
3. **PROOF OF AGE.** Each player and cheerleader must present legal proof of age in the form of an ORIGINAL state issued birth certificate (or the equivalent document for those born outside the United States). Photocopies are NOT acceptable. You must provide this birth certificate before the first week of August. Arrange now to have the proper documents available when they are requested by the LPJF Board or team staff. It shall be a condition of membership to provide such proof for players/cheerleaders.
4. **REPORT CARDS.** It is mandatory, and a condition of membership, to provide proof of scholastic fitness for every player and cheerleader. You must submit a copy of the most current report card at the time of sign ups. Those not providing said documentation will be expelled from LPJF.
5. **REGISTRATION FEES (DUES).** Registration fee for football players and cheerleaders must be paid before equipment issue date. **The registration fee must be submitted with this form.** There will be a \$30.00 service charge assessed for ALL returned checks, including those for registration. All registration fees are mandatory and are a condition of membership. (Calif. Corp. Code § 5311 & 5351) There is no guarantee expressed or implied that any specific player/cheerleader will be assigned to any specific coach, team, or division. Checks used for registration that are returned to LPJF for any reason shall be grounds for immediate membership termination without further notification.
6. **REFUNDS.** Pursuant to the California Corporations Code (Sections 5351 & 5340) once registration fees, charges, assessments, etc. are tendered to LPJF by a member, LPJF is under no legal obligation to provide a refund. LPJF has a policy of **NO REFUNDS.**
7. **MEMBERSHIP.** Your membership commences the date you properly submit the registration material to LPJF (and LPJF accepts it) and terminates on midnight of December 31 of the current calendar year, when you voluntarily resign, fail to provide mandatory documents when required, or when you are expelled as a result of disciplinary action. Family members enumerated on this form shall be considered members of LPJF. Family members not enumerated on this form **are not** members of LPJF. Adult members have the right to vote for the Board of Directors. LPJF reserves the right to refuse membership. (Calif. Corp. Code §5056, 5310, 5330, 5340-1, and 5610).
8. **OBLIGATIONS.** It is a condition of yours and your child's membership to fulfill the obligations (dues, assessments, fees, finding donors for mandatory fundraisers, snack bar duty, team snacks, returning of equipment, etc.) requested of you by LPJF during your membership. This includes, but is not limited to, the already scheduled mandatory fundraiser, to wit: Raffle Tickets. Should you not find sufficient donors for mandatory fundraisers, you will be assessed the amount expected to be raised. (Calif. Corp. Code §5351, 5340, and 5341(g)).
9. **BY SIGNING THIS AGREEMENT YOU FOREVER WAIVE YOUR CLAIM TO ANY AND ALL MONEYS YOU GIVE, WILL GIVE, OR HAVE GIVEN, TO LPJF IN THE PAST, PRESENT, OR FUTURE.**
10. **EQUIPMENT RESPONSIBILITY.** As parent/guardian of said candidate, I do hereby assume full and complete responsibility for the proper care and maintenance of all equipment loaned by LPJF to said candidate, and agrees to return it upon demand. I understand all equipment is to be used for LPJF activities ONLY and that all equipment remains the legal property of LPJF. I agree to reimburse LPJF for any and all equipment that is lost, damaged or stolen for the full replacement cost of said equipment, with payment due when equipment is requested by LPJF, or immediately upon the withdrawal of said candidate from LPJF. **NOTE:** Players/Cheerleaders may only use LPJF issued equipment and uniforms at practices, games, and competitions (unless as prescribed by a physician).
11. **CONDUCT.** Members whose conduct, in the opinion of LPJF, is a danger or abusive to themselves, or others may be removed from participation. Possession or use of alcoholic beverages at any practice or game field is prohibited. Tobacco use at any practice or game field is prohibited.
12. **GOVERNING RULES & BODY.** All members of LPJF, as a condition of their membership, are obligated to abide by the decisions of the LPJF Board of Directors, league level administration and the following (which shall be considered included in this agreement by their reference):
 1. The rules, policies, and procedures set forth by AMERICAN YOUTH FOOTBALL.
 2. The rules, policies, procedures, and decisions set forth by the Pacific Coast Conference.
 3. The rules, policies, procedures, and by-laws set forth by the Lakewood Pacific Junior Football Board of Directors.
 4. Code of Conduct set forth by the Pacific Coast Conference and Lakewood Pacific Junior Football, Inc.This also includes, but is not limited to, decisions regarding placement of members on teams. This also includes, but is not limited to, decisions regarding refunds. Therefore, members have no right to refunds except as directed by the Board of Directors. Any non-compliance with rules, regulations, policies, procedures, or decisions of the aforementioned shall be cause for disciplinary action to be taken against said candidate, parent/guardian, or team by LPJF, up to and including expulsion.
13. **SEVERABILITY.** Should any portion of this agreement be found invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, all remaining portions shall remain in full force and effect with as much of their original intent as legally possible. This entire agreement shall be governed by the laws of the State of California.
14. **AMENDMENTS.** Amendments may be made to this agreement only by a written instrument, signed by both parties.

In case of injury to my/our child, whose full name and birth date are correctly listed above, I/we with this grant authority to a qualified Doctor of Medicine to render such medical treatment as said Doctor of Medicine deems necessary under the circumstances.

I/We **have read and understand the terms and conditions in this document including but not limited to, the NO REFUND POLICY.** I/We hereby voluntarily agree to the terms, condition, stipulations, and policies contained or referred to herein. I/We agree that this instrument is the express intent of my/our agreement, superseding all others, verbal, written, or otherwise, regarding membership with Lakewood Pacific Junior Football.
